**DECISION OF THE FEDERATION COUNCIL
OF THE FEDERAL ASSEMBLY
OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

**ON
SCHEDULING THE ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE
RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

In accordance with Article 81, subparagraph “d” of paragraph 1 of Article 102 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, paragraphs 2 and 7 of Article 5 of the Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation, the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation **decides:**

1. To schedule the election of the President of the Russian Federation on 18 March 2018.

2. This Decision comes into force after its official publication.

OF THE COPENHAGEN MEETING OF THE
CONFERENCE ON THE HUMAN DIMENSION
OF THE CSCE
(Copenhagen, 1990)
(extract)

The representatives of the participating States of the Conference on Security and Cooperation in Europe (CSCE), Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, Cyprus, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Finland, France, the German Democratic Republic, the Federal Republic of Germany, Greece, the Holy See, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom, the United States of America and Yugoslavia, met in Copenhagen from 5 to 29 June 1990, in accordance with the provisions relating to the Conference on the Human Dimension of the CSCE contained in the Concluding Document of the Vienna Follow-up Meeting of the CSCE.

In order to strengthen respect for, and enjoyment of, human rights and fundamental freedoms, to develop human contacts and to resolve issues of a related humanitarian character, the participating States agree on the following:

<...>

(8) The participating States consider that the presence of observers, both foreign and national, can enhance the electoral process for States in which elections are taking place. They therefore invite observers from any other CSCE participating States and any appropriate private institutions and organizations who may wish to do so to observe the course of their national election proceedings, to the extent permitted by law. They will also endeavour to facilitate similar access for election proceedings held below the national level. Such observers will undertake not to interfere in the electoral proceedings.

**CONVENTION
ON THE STANDARDS OF DEMOCRATIC ELECTIONS,
ELECTORAL RIGHTS AND FREEDOMS IN THE
MEMBER STATES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF
INDEPENDENT STATES**

(Kishinev, 7 October 2002)

(extract)

States party to this Convention (hereinafter referred to as Parties),

proceeding from the goals and principles of the Charter of the
Commonwealth of Independent States,

have agreed upon the following:

**Article 7
Open and Transparent Elections**

<...>

5. Observance of the principle of openness and publicity of elections should provide for establishment of conditions for execution of election monitoring by public and international bodies.

<...>

**Article 15
Status and Powers of International Observers**

1. The Parties hereto proceed from the assumption that the presence of international observers promotes openness and transparency of elections and ensures the observance of international commitments of the states. They will strive to facilitate the access of international observers to election processes being conducted on a lower level than the national one, including the municipal (local) level.

2. Activities of international observers are regulated by the laws of the country of presence, by this Convention and other international documents.

MAJOR AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS TO THE ELECTORAL LEGISLATION MADE IN 2016–2017

2016 saw the revised rules for the conduct of the election campaign come into force.

In particular, one of the major amendments is aimed at ensuring that no “fake” journalist infiltrates polling stations and that no one interferes with the work of election commissions. From now on, in order to work at an electoral station, journalists have to be accredited in a period of time from 55 to 3 days before the election day. Moreover, only a journalist who was hired by a publishing house earlier than 2 months before the official announcement of the date of the election day can be accredited.

Any interference with the work of election commission or with the voting process will be punished by a fine if no criminal basis is found. This fine will amount to 2,000–5,000 roubles for individuals and 20,000–50,000 for officials.

1 June 2017 has seen the publication and coming into force of Federal Laws “on Amendments to the Federal Law on Presidential Election in the Russian Federation”, No. 103-FZ and “on Amendments to Particular Legislative Acts of the Russian Federation” No. 104-FZ.

Federal Law No. 104-FZ introduces amendments to several laws, including the Federal Law “on basic guarantees of electoral rights and the right of citizens of the Russian Federation to participate in a referendum”.

Amendments Introduced by Federal Law No. 104-FZ:

Early and absentee voting was replaced by a new voting mechanism – voting on the basis of an application for enrollment on the voters’ list at the place of temporary stay.

Those voters away from their registration place on the election day have a right to submit an application for enrollment on the voters’ list at the place of their temporary stay directly to the election commission.

The CEC of Russia established the appropriate procedure for submitting applications that introduces a time gap for submitting the application (within a time limit that begins no earlier than 45 days before the day of election and ends at 2.00 p.m. local time of the day preceding the day of election).

The voter may submit such application online, through a Federal State Informational System “Public Services Portal of the Russian Federation” or in person through:

- Any territorial election commission;
- Any precinct election commission;
- Any multi-service center (MFC).

In accordance with the Federal Law of 2 October 2012 No. 157-FZ, the electoral presincts were established for a period of 5 years. Federal Law No. 104-FZ provides that previously established electoral stations shall be deemed to run on a permanent basis, i.e. indefinitely. The corresponding rule came into force on 1 October, 2017.

At the same time, the law introduces the provisions on possible disaggregation of electoral presincts, which implies specifying the list and boundaries of electoral presincts with the aim to reduce the maximum number of voters in electoral presinct down to 1,500 (applied since 1 October, 2017). In addition, since 1 May 2018, it is allowed to specify the list and boundaries of electoral presincts in order to increase the maximum number of voters in electoral presincts up to 3,000 voters, and to make the polling stations most convenient for voters, taking into account the construction of new apartment buildings and houses or the need to change the building of polling stations. Thus, the relevant provisions of Federal Law No. 67-FZ “On basic guarantees of electoral rights and the right of citizens of the Russian Federation to participate in a referendum” shall be applied only after the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

The decision to specify the list of electoral presincts and (or) their borders for the purposes mentioned above may be taken as often as once in every five years. Such a decision shall be adopted beyond the period of the election campaign, and in exceptional cases – no later than 70 days before the day of election.

Federal Law No. 104-FZ stipulates that if the term of office of the election commission expires during the election campaign, new election commission shall not be appointed until the day of official publication of the election results. This rule applies to both election commissions of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and all lower-level commissions, except for district election commission.

The deadline for nomination of candidates for the election commission shall be 30 days and shall begin no earlier than the day of official publication of the results of election, referendum and end no later than 60 days after the official publication of the results of the election, referendum. The new election commission shall hold its first meeting within ten days after the end of the election, referendum campaign.

Taking into account the law enforcement practice, Federal Law No. 67-FZ specifies the procedure for signing a signature sheet in support of nominated candidate and the list of candidates, and stipulates that address of voter’s place of residence may omit some details (name of the constituent entity of the Russian Federation, district, city or other

locality, street, house number and apartment), unless it affects its unambiguous interpretation, given actual residence of the voter. The relevant amendments were made to the forms of signature sheets.

As to the procedure for appointment of observers, federal law may provide exceptions to the general procedure. Thus, Federal Law No. 103-FZ stipulates that the election of the President of the Russian Federation does not require the use of law provisions that consider the appointment of no more than two observers per one electoral station, the appointment of a particular observer for a particular station, and advance submission of observers' lists to the relevant election commission.

In regards to the amendments to the Code of Administrative Offenses of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as the Code of Administrative Offenses), it should be noted that Article 5.6 of the Code of Administrative Offenses "Violation of the Rights of a Member of Election (Referendum) Commission, Observer, Foreign (International) Observer, Accredited Agent or Authorized Representative of a candidate or Association, Member or Authorized representative of the Initiative Group or Other Group of Referendum Participants or Representative of the Mass Media" is deleted from the list of offences which must be documented by police officials, and is included in the list of offences which must be initiated by public prosecutor, that is to say, is included in the exclusive competence of public prosecutor.

In addition, Federal Law of 29 July 2017 No. 249-FZ added the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation with Article 142.2 "Unlawful Issue and Receipt of Voting Papers or Referendum Ballots".

According to the provisions of this article, if a member of election commission issues a ballot paper to a citizen (citizens) to grant him / them the opportunity to vote instead of other voters or to vote more than twice during the same voting, or issues a filled ballot paper, he/she shall be liable either to a fine in the amount of 200,000–500,000 roubles or in the amount of its wage, salary or other income for a period of eighteen months to three years, or to compulsory labour or detention for a period of up to 4 years.

The receipt in the election commission of ballot papers to vote instead of voters or twice during the same voting, shall result in either a fine in the amount of 100,000–300,000 roubles or in the amount of its wage, salary or other income for a period of eighteen months to three years, or in compulsory labour or detention for a period of up to 3 years.

Before this article was added into the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation, administrative liability for so-called "carousel voting" was capped at 50,000 roubles.

SYSTEM OF ELECTORAL AUTHORITIES RESPONSIBLE FOR PREPARATION AND CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Presidential Election in the Russian Federation shall be prepared and conducted by:

- the Central Election Commission (CEC) of the Russian Federation;
- election commissions of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation;

- territorial election commissions - district, city and other election commissions or election commissions of municipal units acting as territorial commissions in cases provided for by the Federal Law on Principal Guarantees of Electoral and Referendum Rights of the Citizens of the Russian Federation;

- precinct election commissions.

TRANSPARENCY OF THE ACTIVITIES OF ELECTION COMMISSIONS

*Extract from Article 23 of the Federal Law on the Election of the
President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003 No. 19-FZ*

1. Members and staff personnel of superior election commissions, a registered candidate or his attorney or authorized representative for financial issues may attend all meetings of any election commission and be present when a precinct, territorial election commission is working with voters' lists, ballots, absentee certificates, protocols of voting results and summary tables. The aforementioned persons shall not need any additional permission to attend the meeting of the relevant election commission and be present when it is working with the aforementioned electoral documents. The relevant election commission shall make arrangements to ensure free access of these persons to its meeting and to the premises where this election commission counts votes and works with the aforementioned documents.

1¹. All meetings of the election commission as well as while working with the voting documents specified in paragraph 1 of this article may be attended by the representatives of mass media, except for the case stipulated in paragraph 1² herein.

1². The meetings of the election commission, when determining the vote returns or election results, as well as when counting the votes, may be attended by representatives of the mass media employed by publishing houses no less than two months prior to the day when the election is officially called, and accredited in accordance with paragraph 14² herein.

<...>

3. When election commissions consider complaints (appeals), their meeting may be attended by the complainants and the representatives of the parties concerned, who may give explanations and submit evidence to the substance of the matter under consideration.

<...>

5. On the voting day and on the days of early voting, the persons mentioned in Clause 1 of this Article as well as observers, foreign (international) observers may be present at polling stations from the time a precinct election commission begins its work and until it is informed that the superior election commission has received a protocol of voting results, and also during vote recount.

6. Observers, foreign (international) observers may be present in other election commissions when these commissions establish voting

results and election results, preparing protocols on voting results, election results and when votes are recounted.

<...>

8. Observers may be appointed by each registered candidate, his/her official representative, each political party which nominated a registered candidate. Eligible to act as an observer shall be a citizen of the Russian Federation who is entitled to an active electoral right. Ineligible for appointment as observers shall be persons occupying elective offices, deputies, top executives of the subjects of the Russian Federation (heads of the highest executive bodies of state power of the subjects of the Russian Federation), heads of local administrations, persons directly subordinated to them, judges, prosecutors, voting members of election commissions, except for those members of election commissions whose rights were suspended in accordance with article 29 paragraph 7 of the Federal Law “on basic guarantees of electoral rights and the right of citizens of the Russian Federation to participate in a referendum” .

**GUARANTEES OF FREE EXPRESSION
OF THE VOTERS' WILL AT THE ELECTION
OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION**

**Article 1 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the
Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ**

1. The President of the Russian Federation shall be elected for six years by citizens of the Russian Federation on the basis of universal, equal, direct suffrage by secret ballot.

2. Participation of a citizen of the Russian Federation in the election of the President of the Russian Federation shall be free and voluntary. Nobody shall have the right to influence a citizen of the Russian Federation so that to compel him/her to participate or not to participate in the election of the President of the Russian Federation and nobody shall interfere with free expression of his/her will.

**Article 10 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the
Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ**

1. The preparation and conduct of the election of the President of the Russian Federation shall be open and transparent.

2. The regulations of bodies of state power and bodies of local self-government, regulations of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation relating to the preparation and conduct of the election of the President of the Russian Federation and the assurance of the electoral rights of citizens shall be officially published in state and municipal print media. Other decisions of these bodies, decisions of other election commissions directly relating to the preparation and conduct of the election shall be also published in the said print media or shall be made public in other ways.

INFORMATION SUPPORT OF THE ELECTION: GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PRE-ELECTION CAMPAIGN

Article 45 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ

The informational support of the election of the President of the Russian Federation shall include information of voters and election campaigning and shall promote conscious expression of their will by voters and openness of the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

Article 8 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ

1. Citizens of the Russian Federation, political parties, other public associations, electoral blocs may conduct election campaigning in any form allowed by law.

2. In this Federal Law “election campaigning” means the activities carried out during the election campaign in the election of the President of the Russian Federation, which aim to encourage or are encouraging voters to vote for or against a candidate or against all candidates.

3. The state shall assure the freedom of election campaigning for citizens of the Russian Federation, political parties, other public associations under this Federal Law, other federal laws.

4. Equal conditions of access to the mass media shall be guaranteed by the state for registered candidates to conduct election campaigning.

ORGANIZATION AND PROCEDURE OF VOTING

Article 69 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ

1. Voting shall be conducted from 8.00 to 20.00 local time. If the polling station occupies the territory of voters' place of residence (or stay) whose working hours overlap the time gap of elections (such as at enterprises with pressing continuity or on a rotational team method), the election commission of the constituent entity of the Russian Federation, by its decision, may reschedule the beginning of voting at the relevant electoral station for an earlier time, but by no more than two hours.

2. Territorial and district election commissions shall inform voters of the day, time and place of voting 30-10 days before the day of election, and in case of early voting, as stipulated in Art. 70 of the Federal Law on Presidential Election in the Russian Federation - no later than five days before the day of early voting.

<...>

8. A voter shall vote by putting a mark in the box relating to the candidate he/she wants to choose or, in the case provided in paragraph 51, Article 67 of Federal Law on Presidential Election in the Russian Federation, by choosing "For" or "Against."

9. Each voter shall vote in person. Voting for other voters shall not be allowed. Ballots shall be marked in a booth or some other place specially fitted out for secret voting, where the presence of other persons shall not be allowed, save as otherwise provided by paragraph 10 of this Article.

10. A voter who is unable to sign or complete a ballot, to participate in electronic voting may be assisted by another voter who is not a member of election commission, registered candidate, his accredited agent or authorized representative for financial matters, authorized representative or accredited agent of political party that nominated its registered candidate, observer or foreigner or (international) observer. In this case, the voter shall orally inform the election commission of his/her intention to ask for assistance of another person.

<...>

PROCEDURE OF DETERMINATION OF VOTE RETURNS AND ELECTION RESULTS BY ELECTION COMMISSIONS

Article 76 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ

1. Based on the data contained in the first copies of protocols on vote returns received from the election commissions of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation and from the territorial election commissions, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation, after making sure that these protocols are properly completed, shall summarize these data within not more than ten days after the election to determine the results of the election of the President of the Russian Federation. The data contained in the protocols of the election commissions shall be summarized by the members of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation who hold the deciding vote.

2. The Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall prepare a protocol of the results of the election of the President of the Russian Federation...

2¹. Based on the protocol on the results of the election of the President of the Russian Federation, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall adopt a resolution on the outcome of the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

3. A registered candidate shall be deemed elected if he received more than a half of the votes cast by voters who took part in the voting. The number of voters who took part in the voting shall be determined from the number of standard ballots found in the ballot boxes.

<...>

Article 77 of Federal Law on the Election of the President of the Russian Federation of 10 January 2003, No. 19-FZ

1. If more than two registered candidates were put on a ballot and none of them was elected President of the Russian Federation according to the results of the general election, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall announce the repeat voting in the election of the President of the Russian Federation on the two candidates who polled the largest number of votes. The repeat voting on a registered candidate shall be announced if the registered candidate has submitted a

written statement expressing his consent for the repeat voting to be held on his candidature.

2. The repeat voting shall be held 21 days after voting day in the general election in compliance with the requirements of this Federal Law.

<...>

4. According to the results of the repeat voting that registered candidate shall be deemed to have been elected to the office of President of the Russian Federation who received more votes cast by voters taking part in the voting than the other registered candidate.

In order to implement requirements of Article 30 of the Federal Law “On Principal Guarantees of Electoral Rights and the Right of Citizens of the Russian Federation to Participate in a Referendum” as well as paragraph 2 of Article 11 and Article 24 of the Federal Law “On Presidential Election in the Russian Federation, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation” **decides:**

1. To approve Guidance for the Activities of Foreign (International) Observers Present at the Election of the President of the Russian Federation (see Annex).

2. To abrogate the Resolution of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation on Guidance for the Activities of Foreign (International) Observers Present at the Election of the President of the Russian and Accreditation of Foreign (International) Observer of 12 May 2011 No. 10/98-6.

3. To publish the present Resolution in the “Vesntik of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation” – the official press organ of the CEC, and on the official website of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation, and to send it to Rossiyskaya Gazeta and Parlamentskaya Gazeta for publication.

Guidance for the Activities of Foreign (International) Observers Present at the Election of the President of the Russian Federation

This Guidance for the Activities of Foreign (International) Observers Present at the Election of the President of the Russian Federation are prepared on the basis of the Federal Law on the “Principal Guarantees of Electoral and Referendum Rights of the Citizens of the Russian Federation”, Federal Law on “Presidential Election in the Russian Federation”, universally recognized principles and standards of international law, international treaties of the Russian Federation, and the Convention on Standards of Democratic Elections, Election Rights and Freedoms of the CIS Member-States.

This Guidance determines the procedure of carrying out activities of foreign (international) observers present at the election of the President of the Russian Federation individually or in groups of observers, and as members of international observer mission.

1. General Provisions

1.1 Foreign (international) observers, in line with this Guidance, are persons who are not the citizens of the Russian Federation and who have the right to monitor the preparation and conduct of elections of the President of the Russian Federation in accordance with the procedure established by law.

Foreign (international) observers shall get a permit to enter the Russian Federation in the manner prescribed by the Federal Law on the “Procedure for Departure from the Russian Federation and Entry to the Russian Federation” and, subject to the invitation stipulated in paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2 herein, shall be accredited by the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation.

1.2 International organizations, according to this Guidance, are:
interstate and intergovernmental organizations - in accordance with the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties (VCLT), and the Federal Law on “International Treaties of the Russian Federation”;

international public associations, in accordance with article 47 of the Federal Law on “Public Associations”, shall not be classified as international organizations.

1.3 In the line with this Guidance, the international organization is a foreign government body or a foreign non-profit organization with legal capacity that allows it to carry out an international observance on the territory of the Russian Federation. The legal status and legal capacity of foreign organizations shall be confirmed by documents recognized as such by the legislation of the country in which such organizations are established.

1.4 In accordance with the norms of international law, foreign or international organizations (their branches, offices, etc.) can be registered and located in and outside the territory of the Russian Federation.

1.5 The term of office of a foreign (international) observer shall begin from the day of his/her accreditation by the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation and ends on the day of the official publication of the final results of the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

1.6 The foreign (international) observer shall conduct his/her activities independently and shall be financially supported by the party that sent him/her.

2. The Procedure of Invitation and Accreditation of Foreign (International) Observers

2.1 Invitations may be sent by the President of the Russian Federation, the chambers of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation, the Government of the Russian Federation, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation after the official publication of the resolution on calling the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

2.2 The Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation extends invitations to foreign electoral bodies and international organizations specializing in electoral legislation and process, protection of human rights to participate in electoral process or referendums, as well as to international Associations of Election Officials.

2.3 Suggestions on extending of invitations could be made by the Commissioner for Human Rights of the Russian Federation, international and national governmental and non-governmental organizations and by individuals with recognized authority in the sphere of protection of human and civil rights.

2.4 To be accredited as a foreign (international) observer to the election of the President of the Russian Federation, a person who meets the requirements set out in paragraphs 1.2 and 1.3 herein, shall submit

an application for accreditation as a foreign (international) observer in the prescribed form, a questionnaire filled in by himself/herself (Annex No. 1), a copy of invitation from any authority or person specified in paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2 herein, and a copy of identification document to the body authorized to invite foreign (international) observers.

2.5 After verification of the documents specified in paragraph 2.4 herein, the body authorized to invite foreign (international) observers shall transmit them to the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation for accreditation.

2.6 The documents specified in paragraph 2.4 herein must be submitted to the CEC of Russia not later than ten days before the voting day. Documents received with a violation of this deadline shall not be considered.

2.7 If the submitted documents comply with the prescribed requirements, the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall accredit the applicant as a foreign (international) observer and issue him/her an certification of foreign (international) observer (Annex No. 2).

2.8 The accreditation shall be issued on a three-color (white-blue-red) form, 135x90 mm. The accreditation of foreign (international) observer present at the election of the President of the Russian Federation shall contain the name of the election, the number of the certification, surname and the first name of the foreign (international) observer, name of a country and / or organization that he/she represents and the date of accreditation, and shall be signed by the Chair of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation, and sealed with a hologram of the round official stamp of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation.

The accreditation of foreign (international) observer is valid only on presentation of identification document.

The accreditation of foreign (international) observer is a document which certifies his/her status and gives the foreign (international) observer the right to conduct his/her activities from the date of his/her accreditation by the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation to the date of official publication of the overall results of the election of the President of the Russian Federation.

2.9 The Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall deny an application for accreditation as a foreign (international) observer in the following cases:

– if the foreign (international) organization that has suggested the applicant has no legal capacity to observe the election of the President of the Russian Federation;

- if the applicant fails to submit the documents specified in paragraph 2.4 herein, or if the information provided by the applicant is incomplete or inaccurate;
- if the statutory objectives of the foreign (international) organization or the purposes of its activities, or activities of its representative in the Russian Federation are contrary to the Constitution and legislation of the Russian Federation, and threaten the sovereignty, security, territorial integrity, national unity and national interests of the Russian Federation;
- if previously the applicant for the status of foreign (international) observer lost his/her accreditation as a foreign (international) observer on the territory of the Russian Federation due to violation of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, legislation of the Russian Federation or universally recognized principles and norms of international law;
- if the applicant was denied entry into the Russian Federation or was declared an undesirable person in the Russian Federation, in accordance with the Federal Law on the Procedure for Departure from the Russian Federation and Entry into the Russian Federation.

3. Rights and Guarantees of the Activities of Foreign (International) Observers

3.1 The activities of foreign (international) observers shall be governed by international treaties of the Russian Federation, Federal Law on “the Principal Guarantees of Electoral and Referendum Rights of the Citizens of the Russian Federation”, Federal Law on “Presidential Election in the Russian Federation” and other federal laws.

3.2 During his/her stay on the territory of the Russian Federation, the foreign (international) observer shall enjoy the protection of the Russian Federation. The election commissions of all levels, federal government authorities and authorities of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, other public authorities and local governments, and officials shall be obliged to provide him/her with all the necessary assistance within their competence.

3.3 The foreign (international) observers shall be entitled:

3.3.1 To meet Presidential nominees, their accredited agents and authorized representatives on financial issues, authorized representatives of political parties, groups of voters and observers.

3.3.2 To have access to all documents (not relating to the national security and not containing confidential information), that govern the electoral process, and to obtain the necessary information and copies of protocols on the vote returns and the outcome of election from the election commissions.

3.3.3 To be present in the electoral precincts, including those outside the Russian Federation, and at the electoral stations, from the moment when the district election commissions start working on the election day and the days of early voting until the day of adoption of protocol on the vote returns by the higher election commission, as well as when re-counting votes.

3.3.4 To be present when the territorial election commissions and election commissions of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation determine the vote returns, when the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation determines the election results, when the above mentioned commission makes up the relevant protocols on the vote returns and election results, and when these commissions recount the votes.

3.3.5 To examine the voters' lists, information on voters who applied for enrollment on the voters' lists at the place of temporary stay, and register of applications for voting outside the electoral station in the relevant constituent entity of the Russian Federation.

3.3.6 To supervise the issue of voting papers (ballots) to voters.

3.3.7 To familiarize themselves with the operation of the technical facilities for vote counting (touch-screen voting machines, electronic voting systems complexes for electronic voting) and to monitor how the election commission use them on the day of election.

3.3.8 To monitor the count of voters enrolled on the voters' list; the count of voting papers (ballots) and invalidated (cancelled) voting papers (ballots); and the counts of votes at the electoral stations at a distance and in conditions that enable them to see the marks made by voters in the voting papers (ballots); and to examine any completed voting paper (ballot) or any voting paper (ballot) left blank when counting votes.

3.3.9 To be present when district election commission determines and announces the summarized data based on the voters' list before the count of votes.

3.3.10 To examine the voting papers (ballots) sorted by votes cast for each of the registered candidates under control of the district election commission which shall have the casting vote.

3.3.11 To monitor the election commission when compiling a protocol on the vote returns and other documents from the moment when the district election commissions start working on the election day and the days of early voting until the day of adoption of protocol on the vote returns by the higher election commission, as well as when re-counting votes.

3.3.12 To examine the protocols of the vote returns and the election results; and to get certified copies of these protocols from the relevant election commission.

3.3.13 To inform representatives of election commissions of the findings of their observations without interfering in their work.

3.3.14 To attend the final meeting of the district election commission, which examines complaints and allegations of violations related to the voting and vote counts.

3.3.15 To familiarize themselves with the results of examination of complaints (applications) related to violation of the legislation on elections.

3.3.16 To obtain from the relevant election commission the summarized vote returns at each electoral station in the electoral precinct it is in charge of, and the election results to the extent of its protocol on the vote returns and protocols on the vote returns of lower commissions.

3.3.17 To photograph and (or) make videos at the electoral stations (from the point indicated by the chairperson of the district election commission) with prior notification to the chairperson, deputy chairperson or secretary of the district election commission.

3.3.18 To represent their views (assessments) on the legislation of the Russian Federation on elections, and on the preparation and conduct of the elections of the President of the Russian Federation publicly (including via the Internet), to hold press conference and to contact mass media at the end of the voting on the entire territory of the Russian Federation.

3.3.19 To provide the organizers of the election, government authorities and officials with their opinion on the results of monitoring the preparation and conduct of the election.

4. Obligations of Foreign (International) Observers and Responsibility for Violation of the Legislation on Elections and the Rights of Foreign (International) Observers

4.1 The foreign (international) observers shall be obliged:

4.1.1 To act in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and federal laws of the Russian Federation, resolutions of the Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation, generally recognized principles and norms of international law.

4.1.2 To pursue their functions as international observers present at the election of the President of the Russian Federation, guided by the principles of political neutrality, impartiality, respect for the national sovereignty of the Russian Federation and refusal to express any preferences with regard to election commissions, government authorities, local authorities, officials or participants in the electoral process.

4.1.3 To be in possession of an accreditation of foreign (international) observer and identification document when visiting election commissions of all levels, federal government authorities and authorities of

the constituent entities of the Russian Federation, other state agencies and governments, and to present them at the request of election organizers or other officials.

4.1.4 To monitor the election, without interfering in the election campaign at any stage, including pre-election campaign, voting, count of votes and determination the vote returns, as well as the processes following the day of election.

4.1.5 To base their conclusions on the findings of observation and facts (factual information).

4.2 A foreign (international) observer shall not have the right:

- to carry out activities that either contribute to or inhibit Presidential nominees, election of the registered candidates, and achievement of a certain result of the election of the President of the Russian Federation;

- to issue voting papers (ballots) to voters;

- to sign for voting papers (ballots) instead of voter, including at his/her request;

- to complete voting papers (ballots) instead of voter, including at his/her request;

- to take actions that violate the secrecy of voting;

- to take direct part in the counting of voting papers (ballots) conducted by members of the election commission who have the casting vote;

- to take actions impeding the work of the election commission;

- to conduct pre-election campaign among voters;

- participate in decision-making processes in the relevant election commission.

4.3 The foreign (international) observers shall not be entitled to exercise their rights and fulfill their obligations in a manner different from that prescribed in paragraphs 3.3, 4.1 and 4.2 herein, and to use their status to carry out activities not related to monitoring of the course of the election campaign, and preparation and conduct of the Presidential election in the Russian Federation.

4.4 The Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall have the right to deprive a foreign (international) observer of accreditation if he/she violates federal laws or generally recognized principles and norms of international law.

The Central Election Commission of the Russian Federation shall take a special resolution on deprivation of the foreign observer of accreditation.

4.5 Persons violating the rights of foreign (international) observers shall be liable in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation.
